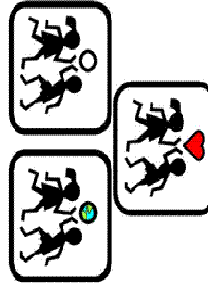

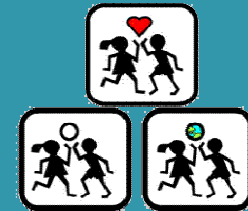
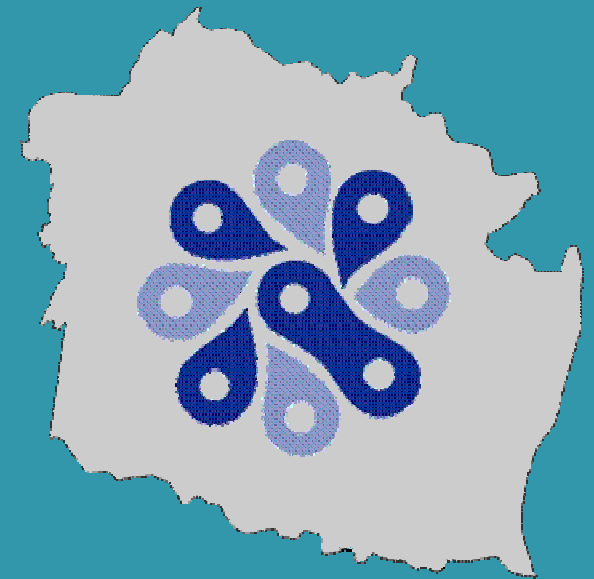

Bikes Belong in Camden Membership dues:

Add *bike racks* in Camden. Being able to ride a bike to the grocery store to pick up a few items is nice, but not if we don't have a safe place to put our bicycle.

Advocate for designated bike paths and routes. We work for more designated bike routes, multi-use paths and BMX trails and ramps.

Educate cyclists and motorists on how to share the road. We can also educate the community on the value of alternate transportation.

Encourage more individuals to use the designated paths and routes. Printed maps for cyclists are available to use to identify designated bike and pedestrian plans.

Provide *funding* for trails and trail development. With funding decreasing, Bikes Belong in Camden leverages the cost of extending paths and building new paths and trails through planning, property acquisition, trailhead development and other infrastructure improvements.

Build more opportunities for *civic engagement*. Bring people together and providing connectivity is a great part of living in Camden County.



Support *signage and street markings* on current and future routes. Marking the safe routes in our community will make bicycling more safe and enjoyable for the children, families, cycling enthusiasts and the whole community.

Promote *Safe Routes to Schools* in Camden County. Encouraging students to walk and bike to school reduces unnecessary transportation costs and helps students be more alert, aware and ready to learn.

Market cycling as part of community development. We are building Bike Friendly Communities. Cycling commuters to work and school help keep our air clean and our roads less congested with traffic.

Advance health. "Even a small amount of cycling can lead to significant health gains" through reduced rates of diabetes, heart disease, obesity, depression and stress.
